**Pslam 119:9**

**DAY 1 – PASSAGE: GENESIS 39:1-23**

How did God bless Joseph in the midst of adversity? (Genesis 39:1-6)

Describe how Potiphar's wife sought to tempt Joseph?

List the ways Joseph handled this temptation in a way that brought "Glory to God."

What temptations of impurity do you anticipate facing today?

What is your action plan to bring "Glory to God" through these temptations?

**DAY 2 – PASSAGE: 2 SAMUEL 11**

In 2 Samuel 11:1, explain how David’s choice to remain at Jerusalem was unwise?

Explain the circumstances that led to the temptation, and how David could have avoided it?

How did David seek to cover his own sin?

How did David’s desire to cover up his sin affect Bathsheba, Uriah, and Joab?

What are some unwise choices you have made that have led to your own impurity?

What have you learned from this story that will help you consider the importance of living pure?

**DAY 3 – PASSAGE: PSALM 51 – DAVID’S REPENTANCE FROM HIS SIN WITH BATHSHEBA**

List the Scripture reference to the truth that stood out to you in your reading?

What does David ask God to give to him? On what basis does David anticipate God’s action?

How can a person be thoroughly and cleansed from their sin of an impure life?

What did David recognize about his sin? (Psalm 51:3-6)

What is significant about David's request for God to "Create in him a clean heart and renew a right spirit within him?"

Write out a definition of "Repentance" according to Psalm 51.

List two ways these truths will impact your life today and help you to live in purity.
