
(REMINDER: READ SCRIPTURE CAREFULLY AND CONTEXTUALLY)

Keys Questions for Reading Carefully and Contextually:

1. Author – Who is the author and why does it matter?
2. Audience – Who are the recipients of the teaching?
3. Aim – What instruction is the author giving and why is it important to them?
4. Application – What principles can I learn from the instruction and how does it connect with my life.
