

HEART- thinking, desires, motivation

Scripture tells us exactly how to protect and guard our inner man. This is always the focus of the Scriptures — the inner man. Christianity is no mere system of DO's and DON'Ts. The **heart**, the inner man, must be right **or the man himself is not right**.

Our **heart**—our inner man —dictates how we live. Solomon tells us to guard our heart above all else making sure we concentrate on **those desires** that will keep us on the right path. Make sure your affections push you in the right direction. Put boundaries on your desires, don't go after everything you see, look straight ahead, keep your eyes fixed on your goal, and don't get sidetracked on detours that lead to sin!
